

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE PUBLICATION OF WORKS IN THE REVISTA DE ESTUDIOS ECONÓMICOS Y EMPRESARIALES

1. Only original works will be accepted.

2. Articles must be delivered, without color, with a spacing of 1.5. The recommended length per article is between 15 to 50 pages. In the text should be included, without color, charts, tables or figures that are considered appropriate.

3. The first page will only show the title of the article centered, in the language the work is published and below its English translation.

4. The second page the title of the article will be centered (only in the language that is published), and the name of the author or authors in a second line, indicating under the name of each author, the profession, academic rank, etc. Then, on the same sheet with the following order, will appear:

- The index (if the work has it).
- A summary in Spanish (or in the language in which the work is published) with a maximum of 200 words. And along with this summary 3 to 6 key words that give a quick idea of the work content must be specified, and JEL classification (Journal of Economic Literature).
- The English translation of the summary, key words and JEL classification, unless the work is published in English.

5. If the article has the following sections, it will follow the next guidelines according to the font type (preferably Arial) and numbering:

1. INTRODUCTION (bold, 13 points)

1.1. CHARACTERS (12 points)

1.1.1. Notion (italic, bold, 12 points)

6. Underlining will not be used. To enhance the phrases, italics, bold or italics-bold options will be used.

7. Notes will be included in the footer. In any case, they can be developed following one of these two ways (A or B):

- A) - If the quote is from a book: Surname and initial of the name of the author (s) in capital letters, title in italic letters, publishing house, edition, city, year of publication and pages. For example: PANERO GONZALEZ, J.P.: *Historia de la Economía*, Ed. Tecnos, 3ª. ed., Madrid, 1965, p. 65 et seq.
- If the quote is from a journal: surname and first letter of the author (s) in capital letters, title of article in quotation marks, journal name in italic letters, volume number, year of publication in parentheses, and pages. For example: SÁNCHEZ GÓMEZ, P.: "Estudios Económicos de Extremadura", in *Revista de Estudios Económicos y Empresariales* [or acronym *REEE*], 7 (1995), p. 5-120.
 - If a first quote has already been made, it can be quoted as follows: BREAD GONZALEZ, J.P.: op. cit., p. 87; or loc. cit., or ibidem, etc.

- B) - If the quote is from a book: Surname and initial of the name of the author (s) in capital letters, year of publication in parentheses, title in italic letters, publishing house, edition, city, and pages. For example: PANERO GONZÁLEZ, J.P. (1965): *Historia de la Economía*, Ed. Tecnos, 3ª. ed., Madrid, p. 65 et seq.
- If the quote is from a journal: surname and first letter of the author (s) in capital letters, year of publication in parentheses, article title in quotation marks, journal name in italic letters, volume number, and pages. For example: SÁNCHEZ GÓMEZ, P. (1995), "Estudios Económicos de Extremadura", in *Revista e Estudios Económicos y Empresariales* [or acronym *REEE*], 7, p. 5-120.
 - If a first quote has already been made, it can be quoted as follows: PANERO GONZALEZ, J.P. (1965): op. cit., p. 87; or loc. cit., or ibidem, etc.

8. Bibliographical references, if any, will appear at the end of the article ordered alphabetically under the heading BIBLIOGRAPHY, and it can be done in one of these two ways (A or B):

- A) - For books: surname and first letter of the author (s) in capitals, title in italic letters, publishing house, edition, city and year of publication. For example: PANERO GONZALEZ, J.P.: *Historia de la Economía*, Ed. Tecnos, 3ª. ed., Madrid, 1965.
- For journals: surname and first letter of the author (s) in capital letters, title of article in quotation marks, journal name in italic letters, volume number and year of publication in parentheses. For example: SÁNCHEZ GÓMEZ, P.: "Estudios Económicos de Extremadura", in *Revista de Estudios Económicos y Empresariales* [or acronym *REEE*], 7 (1995).
- B) - For books: surname and first letter of the author (s) in capitals, year of publication in parentheses, title in italic letters, publishing house, edition and city. For example: PANERO GONZÁLEZ, J.P. (1965): *Historia de la Economía*, Ed. Tecnos, 3ª. ed., Madrid.
- For journals: surname and first letter of the author (s) in capitals, year of publication in parentheses, article title in quotation marks, journal name in italic letters, and volume number. For example: SÁNCHEZ GÓMEZ, P. (1995): "Estudios Económicos de Extremadura ", in *Revista de Estudios Económicos y Empresariales* [or acronym *REEE*], 7.

9. Works will be reviewed independently by three external reviewers, the Editorial Board will be ultimately responsible for acceptance. The reviews will be peer double blind, so that evaluators do not know the identity of the authors in the time of the review.

10. The acceptance or rejection of the work will be communicated as soon as possible. For additional information about the editorial policy or the preparation of manuscripts, the Executive Director of the Magazine must be contacted.

11. ASSIGNMENT OF EXPLOITATION RIGHTS ON THE INTERNET: By the fact of publishing in the *Revista de Estudios Económicos y Empresariales*, the authors of the articles and other works expressly cede the exploitation rights, through the Internet or any other telematics network, therefore the *Revista de Estudios Económicos y Empresariales*, by itself or by third parties, can reproduce, convert to any format for the preservation and access, to communicate, and to distribute the texts publicly, partially or completely, of the published works. This assignment is understood on non-exclusive contract, free of charge and indefinitely.

The ownership of moral rights and other intellectual property exploitation of the published works will belong and will remain belonging to the Authors. The *Revista de Estudios Económicos y Empresariales*

acquires only the rights specified above, and cannot do, in any case, a lucrative or a commercial use of the texts.
